PETITION TO SEEK AN ORDER OF PROTECTION FROM DOMESTIC ABUSE

COMES NOW, Petitioner, Sally Sue Bloo, individually, and as natural mother and next friend of Little Boy Bloo, and files this her Petition to Seek an Order of Protection from Domestic Abuse against Chubby Too Bloo, Defendant, as pursuant to Title XXIII of the Choctaw Tribal Code (hereinafter referred to as CTC) and cited as the “Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indians’ Protection from Domestic Abuse Law,” and states the following, to-wit:

I.

The Petitioner and Chubby Too Bloo are residents of the Tucker Community, Choctaw Indian Reservation, Neshoba County, Mississippi, and are enrolled members of the Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indians. The marital home is located at 707 Bloo Lane, Philadelphia, Mississippi 3930.

II.

That Petitioner and Chubby Too Bloo have been married since June of 1989, and have one (1) child together, specifically, Little Boy Bloo, born April 5, 1989.

III.

That Chubby Too Bloo loses his temper and becomes violent towards Petitioner. Most recently, on or about Monday, July 5, 2004, Defendant arrived at the marital residence and

forced Petitioner to get in his car. Petitioner advises that Defendant drove approximately one and one-half miles and ordered Petitioner out of the car. Petitioner indicates that she started walking back towards her house and Defendant got out of his car, threatened to beat her up, and raised his fist as if he were going to hit her. Petitioner advises that Defendant did not strike her but that he did grab her and force her back into the car. Petitioner advises that Defendant then took her back to the marital residence, shoved her down on the bed and held her down before finally releasing her.

Petitioner advises that in January of 2004, Defendant assaulted Petitioner by striking her in the face with his fist.

Petitioner advises that on or about October, 31, 2002, Defendant was charged with domestic battery. Petitioner advises that Defendant struck her repeatedly about the face and body with his fist. Petitioner advises that Choctaw Law and Order arrived during the altercation and arrested Defendant after a short pursuit.

Petitioner advises that in June of 2001, Defendant assaulted her by striking her repeatedly about the face and body with his fist. Petitioner advises that her mother, Cindy Lou Cane, intervened and that Defendant struck Petitioner's mother in the ribs with a stick.

Petitioner advises that on or about Sunday, February 2, 2001, Defendant assaulted Petitioner by striking her numerous times with his fist. Petitioner advises that she was at her mother's residence in the Conehatta Community when Defendant, who had been drinking, became angry and started yelling at her. Petitioner advises that Defendant first struck her in the face with his fist and then struck her twice in the head with his fist. Petitioner indicates that some friends pulled Defendant off of her but he managed to come after her again. Petitioner

advises that Defendant grabbed her and threw her against the car causing Petitioner to fall to the ground. Petitioner indicates that Defendant then began kicking her.

IV.

That Chubby Too Bloo has placed the Petitioner in fear of serious bodily injury, and that as a result, this Court should enter an order of protection pursuant to CTC 23-1-6(1), preventing him from having any contact whatsoever with Petitioner.

V.

That Chubby Too Bloo should be excluded from the marital residence located at 707 Bloo Lane, Philadelphia, Mississippi 39350, and that Petitioner should be awarded all household contents contained therein.

VI.

That Petitioner be awarded temporary custody of the minor child, Little Boy Bloo, with a reasonable visitation schedule to be established by the Court. Further, that Defendant be ordered to pay child support in an amount to be determined by the Court.

VII.

That Petitioner be awarded temporary use and possession of the 2002 Chevrolet Impala.

VIII.

That Chubby Too Bloo be prohibited from the transferring, encumbering, or otherwise disposing of property mutually owned or leased by the parties, except when in the ordinary course of business.

WHEREFORE PREMISES CONSIDERED, Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court schedule a hearing pursuant to CTC 23-1-6(1), and that a Protective Order be entered pursuant to CTC 23-1-7(1) against Chubby Too Bloo on behalf of Petitioner, individually, and as

natural mother and next friend of Little Boy Bloo, thereby ordering Chubby Too Bloo to have no contact whatsoever with Petitioner and thereby preventing Chubby Too Bloo from access to the residence located at 707 Bloo Lane, Philadelphia, Mississippi 39350. Further, Petitioner requests that she be awarded temporary custody of the minor child subject to a reasonable visitation schedule by Defendant. And that Defendant be ordered to pay child support in an amount to be determined by the Court. Petitioner requests that she be awarded temporary use and possession of the 2002 Chevrolet Impala. Additionally, Petitioner requests that Chubby Too Bloo be prohibited from the transferring, encumbering, or otherwise disposing of property mutually owned or leased by the parties, except when in the ordinary course of business. And Petitioner prays for any general relief that she may be entitled pursuant to CTC 23-1-7(1)(a) through (g).
